We are excited to announce that Professor Sir Marc Feldmann FRS will be joining us as a special guest speaker at WCP2022.

Professor Marc Feldmann

Sir Marc Feldmann is Emeritus Professor at the [Kennedy Institute of Rheumatology, University of Oxford](#).

He was recently awarded the 2020 Tang Prize in Biopharmaceutical Science. It was in recognition of his work in identifying tumour necrosis factor (TNF) as a good therapeutic target in rheumatoid arthritis and for developing an anti-TNF antibody which proved to be very effective against rheumatoid arthritis as well as inflammatory bowel disease, psoriasis and other conditions.



The Tang Prize Foundation have said that "anti-TNF therapy is a major advance in the treatment of autoimmune and inflammatory diseases" and that Professor Feldmann has transformed his findings into a "powerful therapy".

Professor Feldmann [has said](#) that his current priority is to evaluate whether anti-TNF will be an effective treatment for the hyperinflammation in COVID-19.

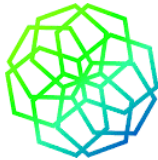
Satellite meeting proposals
